

What Is 4-H?

4-H is a youth organization whose mission is engaging youth to reach their fullest potential while advancing the field of youth development.

Is 4-H For Me?

- YES! Anyone can be in 4-H!
- Open to youth 5 19 years of age.
- Adults can participate in different volunteer roles.
- 4-H does not have specific membership requirements.

How does it work?

- 4-H members learn by doing within project areas ranging from photography to beef cattle to robotics to food preservation!
- Youth and adults meet monthly for club meetings staying in touch via email and social media groups.
- 4-H members have opportunities to grow leadership and civic engagement skills at the club, county, state, and national level!













How Can You Get Involved?

Getting involved with 4-H is easy and costs are kept to a minimum. Unlike other youth organizations, 4-H doesn't require a uniform and there are no national fees. Children select their 4-H project so they can choose one that works well within a family's budget.

4-H programs and clubs typically meet once per month and are available for youth ages 5-13th grade.


